The Government is of the firm view, that such a tendency shall have to be checked. Liberal views in this regard with a view to earn more money will be detrimental to the interests of the media and will be an injustice to the viewers. The Government also proposes to prescribe a time limit to advertisements and will also bring in a touch of Indian culture to the same.

Today, the country is facing communal stresses and strains. Day in and day out, we read the reports of communal disharmony from one part of the country or the other. If this is allowed to go unchecked, this will weaken the nation. Therefore, a much greater awareness in this direction has become all the more necessary. The

Government is of the firm opinion that priority should be given to programmes highlighting social injustices and social exploitations. The corporation will make special efforts to highlight the rich and colourful cultures of the various regions of our country. This will help us to know and understand one another better and in the ultimate analysis promote national integration.

The Government has powers to advice the Corporation not to broadcast a new item that is likely to create public disorder or endanger the unity and integrity of the country. The Government has also the power to direct the Corporation to broadcast a news item, if it is in the public interest.
